

The 8th RIRL Doctoral Seminar

The 8th RIRL Doctoral Seminar will take place at the conference venue (BEM Bordeaux Management School) in Bordeaux (France) on September 29 2010 Wednesday (afternoon).

Objective

The RIRL Doctoral Seminar is meant for students who are in the first and second year of their studies. It provides PhD students with a forum for presenting and discussing their research and an opportunity to get feedback from and exchange comments and views with experienced researchers in the field.

The discussion will focus on design and preliminary results.

Faculty

A faculty of renowned scholars will take part in the Doctoral Seminar, provide support and feedback, share their experiences, and engage actively in the discussions.

Application

To apply for participation in the Doctoral Seminar three pages summarizing research design, methodology, expected results and problems encountered. This document should present five to ten major references to the project.

The first page should include :

- the title or the subject,
- the name of the PhD student,
- his/her personal details university,
- research center,
- thesis director,
- A maximum of five key words.

These documents must be sent no later than 15 April 2010 by e-mail at doct.rirl2010@bem.edu

Notification and preparation

Applicants will be notified of acceptance or rejection of their proposal by 13 May 2010. Successful applicants will then asked to prepare and submit no later than 17 June 2010 a powerpoint presentation (max. 10 Slides) describing their research design, the preliminary results and conclusions of their research.

Fee

Accepted students participating in the Doctoral Seminar should register for the seminar through the RIRL registration page. The fee for the RIRL Conference including Doctoral Seminar are 180 euros.
